#### **About the Market**

This Banff Powwow is one of the first of the season on the Alberta Powwow circuit and is expected to attract over 500 competitors and visitors from around North America. The Powwow will provide each eligible vendor free of charge: one 8' table and two chairs in the beautiful indoor concourse of the Fenlands Recreation Centre.

**Vendor Selection: The market is only accepting handmade original indigenous merchandise.** No food or beverages will be permitted to be sold. Vendor applications are accepted until midnight **June 10<sup>th</sup>**. The first 20 eligible vendors applying will be assigned one table each and notified of their successful application. The day of the Powwow, vendors with reserved tables must be present at the reception desk of the venue no later than 10 am; thereafter, tables will be assigned to vendors who are present, on a first-come, first-serve basis. Table location assignment is at the discretion of the Powwow staff. Vendors are asked to notify Laurin Duncan as soon as possible to cancel a table reservation.

**Setup and Takedown:** Tables must be manned by the vendor for the duration of the Powwow from setup to takedown. Setup is 9 – 11 am. Parking is available onsite. Vendors are responsible to maintain the table and surrounding space in an attractive neat manner. Vendors are reminded to bring their business cards, electrical cords, table clothes, and a cart if necessary to move product. Vendors are encouraged to stay open until 10 pm, and are asked to close no earlier than 8 pm. Please leave your table and space clean after takedown and vacate the building by 11 pm.

**Market Guidelines:** No pets in the building. No smoking in the building. Deposit garbage in eco-friendly bins provided. Courtesy is required by vendors to all Powwow staff, competitors, visitors, and other vendors. Powwow security reserve the right to ask a vendor to leave the market and the building if failing to abide by guidelines. Powwow management has the right to alter, amend, or introduce new guidelines at any time. The Iniskim Powwow Committee, Buffalo Nations Museum, Fenlands Recreation Centre, and our supporters are not responsible/liable for theft, injury, accidents, travel funds. This is a drug and alcohol-free powwow and aims to be waste-free.
